**The response after the conferences in 2013 and 2014:**

**The themes of the previous two conferences were as follows:**

- *Present State and Development* (September 26, 2013) and
- *The Urgency of International Cooperation* (May 19, 2014).

## **The need for „break through“:**

- an open and thorough dialogue between domestic energy policy-makers is necessary,
- a basis for the unification of external viewpoints is needed,
- equal inclusion within the European Union's Energy Policy is a key issue,
- the national energy policy should be based on national consensus,
- more conscious and ambitious national policy is required.

**There are several current themes in the energy field to be discussed:**

- The **European economy** is more than ever merged with world economies,
- The **Energy Union** is reality,
- The **2015 COP 21 United Nations Climate Change Conference** in Paris (2015) – a set of ambitious goals,
- **Energy Concept of Slovenia (ECS)** – energy strategy is on procedure.
